Founded by soprano Lizzie Holmes in 2015, DEBUT has worked with over 180 musicians from opera singers to harpists, string quartets to classical guitar duos. We love sharing exceptional music in a less formal way and through our concerts we encourage audiences to get to know the personalities behind the music.

Recent highlights include a string of concerts with the Royal Opera House, including at their iconic Crush Room and collaborations with the Cutty Sark in Greenwich, Old Operating Theatre and ongoing partnership with the Shoreditch Treehouse. We've been featured by Steinway & Sons, Opera Now, Dorset Living, Classical Music Magazine and on BBC Radio 3's In Tune.

In addition to our intimate concerts, we bring the very best classical musicians to the world of corporate and private events and weddings. Working across the UK, our recent highlights have included providing musicians for the Dorchester, Brocket Hall, the Birley Clubs in Mayfair, the Royal Academy of Arts, the London Science Museum, Proms on the Roof for Kensington Roof Gardens and Hôtel de Paris Monte-Carlos.

LIZZIE HOLMES SOPRANO & FOUNDER OF DEBUT CO-PRODUCER

Lizzie Holmes is a graduate of the Royal College of Music and University of Warwick. As a soloist she's performed across the UK's top concert halls, for Grange Park Opera, Longborough and Wexford Festivals, Raymond Gubbay, at the Royal Opera House's Crush Room and on the West End in *The Phantom of the Opera*. Highlight roles include Mimi & Musetta/La bohème (Olivier Award Nominee 'Best New Opera'), Cunegonde/Candide, Laurette/Doctor Miracle and the title roles of Sāvitri, Poppea and Gretel. Lizzie returns to the RCM as a Guest Lecturer on Creative Enterprise. Highlights in 2021 include debuts as The Queen of the Night, Donna Elvira/Don Giovanni, Frasquita/Carmen and Despina/Così fan tutte.



JOANNA HARRIES MEZZO-SOPRANO CO-PRODUCER

Joanna Harries is a graduate of Cambridge University, the Royal Northern College of Music and Royal Conservatoire of Scotland. She's performed with Welsh National Opera, Scottish Opera, Opera Holland Park, Grange Park Opera, Longborough Opera and British Youth Opera and is a Britten-Pears Young Artist. Highlight roles include Varvara/*Káťa Kabanová*, Zerlina/*Don Giovanni*, Karolka/*Jenufa*, Forester's Wife/*The Cunning Little Vixen* and the title roles of Sāvitri and Dido. She also works extensively in outreach, leading workshops and interactive concerts for all ages, including for the Royal Opera House "Opera Dots" programme.



THOMAS PAYNE CONDUCTOR

For the past two seasons Thomas was on the music staff at The Royal Opera House, Covent Garden, working on both ballet and opera productions. He is Musical Director of London City Orchestra and has been Assistant Conductor and Chorus Master for Grange Park Opera and Longborough Festival Opera.



THOMAS ANG PIANIST & RÉPÉTITEUR

An experienced pianist and chamber musician, Thomas Ang has a wideranging repertoire and an interest in the neglected, the obscure, and the contemporary, gaining critical attention for his thoughtful programming and unusual recitals. He also plays the violin, arranges and edits music, and does calligraphy in his quieter moments.



DOMINIC BEVAN TENOR

Dominic is a graduate of the Royal College of Music and the Sorbonne in Paris where he read English and French Law as an undergraduate. In 2015, after five years in financial services, Dominic decided to embrace a career in opera. A finalist of the 2019 Wagner Society competition at Wigmore Hall, his operatic roles include Tamino/*Die Zauberflöte* and Rodolfo/*La Bohème* (Westminster Opera), Lenski/*Eugene Onegin* (The People's Opera) & Conrad for Tête à Tête Opera directed by Bill Bankes-Jones. Notable solo oratorio performances include the Mozart Requiem, Rossini Petite Messe Solennelle, Verdi Requiem and Britten St Nicolas.



ELEANOR BURKE DIRECTOR

Eleanor is the Artistic Director of Green Opera. Credits include *Carmen* (West Road Concert Hall), *Die Zauberflöte* (Opera Kensington), *Tosca* (Bridgetower Trio). In 2021 Eleanor will be directing *Bluebeard's Castle* (Green Opera). A Fellow at the Guildhall School of Music & Drama, Eleanor has assisted Daisy Evans, Stuart Barker, James Hurley, Julia Mintzer and Martin Lloyd-Evans and will be a Movement Director at Berlin Opera Academy 2021.



SOFIA CASTILLO FLUTE

Sofia Castillo is the Recipient of the 2020 1st Prize of the 28th Gianluca Campochiaro International Music Competition's Chamber Music Category with pianist Marie Otaka. She won the Royal College of Music's 2017 Solo Flute Prize Competition and the Edward and Helen Hague Senior Woodwind Prize. Sofia is a graduate of the Royal College of Music (Master of Performance) as a Doctor Knobel Fund Scholar.



PATRICK DAVIES CLARINET & FLUTE

Patrick Davies is a clarinettist and reed player based in London. Originally an orchestral clarinettist, his varied career encompasses chamber music, musical theatre and jazz, and sees him play a multitude of clarinets, flutes and saxophones. As a soloist, Patrick has performed concertos by Stanford, Giacinto Scelsi, Weber and Mozart.



CHARLOTTE DIAMOND MEZZO-SOPRANO

Charlotte is a recent graduate of Trinity Laban Conservatoire of Music and Dance. Performance highlights include the title role in Britten's *The Rape of Lucretia* (Trinity Laban Opera), Hansel/Hansel and Gretel, Nero/The Coronation of Poppea and concerts with the Early Music Summer School at the Conservatorium van Amsterdam. She is taught by Neil Baker and receives coaching from Jennifer Larmore.



GUY ELLIOTT TENOR

Winner of the Britten-Pears Prize at the 2019 Wigmore Hall International Song Competition, Guy is a graduate of the Royal College of Music where he studied on a full scholarship. Guy is an experienced soloist and has performed with companies including English Touring Opera and Wexford Festival Opera (title role in Bizet's *Doctor Miracle*) and at venues including the Royal Albert Hall, Wigmore Hall and St. Stephen's Cathedral, Vienna. In 2020 Guy founded Workbox Music, a music teaching service based in South West London.



ELLA JOY SOPRANO

Ella is a young up and coming soprano. Having studied her undergraduate degree in French at UCL, Ella now studies under Neil Baker. Highlights include Leila/Les pêcheurs de perles (scenes) directed by Christopher Cowell, Strategist/On Behalf of a Madman (cover), Donna Elvira/Don Giovanni (scenes) directed by Ashley Dean, and Iphigénie/Iphigénie en Tauride (scenes) directed by Jack Furness. Ella previously performed with UC Opera as Inès/La favorite (Donizetti) and with King's College Opera as Titania/The Fairy Queen (Purcell).

Camilla Kerslake is a BRIT nominated soprano who has received international acclaim performing in arenas and stadiums all over the world. Camilla's career highlights include Arena Tours at the 02 alongside Andrea Bocelli and II Divo, vocals for an Oscar and BAFTA nominated motion picture and starring as the NFL's anthem singer during their London games. Camilla was the first signing to Gary Barlow's Universal label, Future Records and has released two studio albums, her self titled debut followed by Moments in 2011. Camilla has performed for Her Majesty the Queen and the Royal Family at Buckingham Palace, Windsor Castle, The Houses of Parliament and the Royal Albert Hall.



KIERAN RAYNER BARITONE

London-based New Zealand baritone Kieran Rayner graduated from the Royal College of Music International Opera School in 2018. He has been a Young Artist with Garsington Opera, Independent Opera, Verbier Festival, Samling Arts, Britten Pears Foundation, and the Internationale Meistersinger Akademie. He was a Wigmore Hall International Song Competition semifinalist 2019, and won the Royal Overseas League Crashaw Prize for Outstanding Overseas Musician 2018. Career venue highlights include the Royal Albert Hall and Buckingham Palace. He has performed opera and song all around the UK, as well as in France, Germany, Italy, Switzerland, Singapore, New Zealand and beyond.



ANDREW TIPPLE BASS-BARITONE

Andrew is a graduate of the Royal Conservatoire of Scotland's Opera Studio and King's College Cambridge where he read History as an undergraduate. Andrew's opera highlights include Fasolt/Das Rheingold (Arcola Theatre), The King/Aurora (Bury Court Opera), both Antonio (Nevill Holt Opera) and Bartolo (Kilden Theatre, Norway) in *Le nozze di Figaro* and Zaretsky/*Eugene Onegin* (Garsington Opera). Concert highlights include Bach Cantatas (King's Place) and Serenade to Music (Cadogan Hall). Other projects include the singer in *Henry IV Parts I and II* with the RSC and the 2015 Turner prize nominated exhibition 'Doug' by Janice Kerbel.
