Lizzie Holmes soprano & founder of DEBUT

Dorset born, British soprano Lizzie Holmes has performed across the UK's top concert halls and on the West End in the Olivier Award nominated *La Bohème* (Mimi) and *The Phantom of the Opera* (Madame Giry). Recognised for her 'luminous singing and sensitive acting' (The Spectator), Lizzie's operatic roles include Despina *Così fan tutte* (Longborough Festival), Queen of the Night *The Magic Flute* (Oxford Playhouse), Laurette *Doctor Miracle* (Wexford Festival), Dew Fairy *Hänsel und Gretel* (Grange Park Opera), Cunegonde *Candide* (Minack Theatre), Euridice *Orfeo ed Euridice* (Arcola Theatre) and the title role in *The Coronation of Poppea* (Ryedale Festival).

Recently Lizzie made her Royal Opera House Crush Room recital debut and was headline soloist with Raymond Gubbay's Johann Strauss Gala, touring to Royal Festival Hall, St David's Hall, Birmingham Symphony Hall and Barbican Hall. A graduate of the Royal College of Music, Lizzie has given recitals at the Royal Albert Hall, St Martin-in-the-Fields as a Concordia Foundation Artist and joined the Bands of the Household Division as soprano soloist at Cadogan Hall. Lizzie has also recorded for *Military Wives* (Lionsgate) and filmed for *The Great* (Channel 4) and *The Crown* (Netflix).

Some career highlights include appearing as a soloist in a concert celebrating the work of renowned lyricist Sir Tim Rice hosted by Sir Tim himself, alongside starring in a revival of his show "Blondel", Alan Menken's "A Christmas Carol" with the London Musical Theatre Orcherstra featuring Robert Lindsay and appearing in the prestigious English National Opera's workshop of the opera Between Worlds.

David has a Cabaret drag alter ego Miss Davida Loca, and is in the process of developing and co-writing a comic show with DEBUT combining the worlds of Opera and Drag. This summer he spent the week at Lighthouse in Poole developing the show as part of SANCTUARY. David is delighted to be joining DEBUT again this Christmas.

Manu Brazo

saxophonist



Manu Brazo is an innovative musician who is redefining the concept of the classical musician in the 21st Century. Considered one of the most influential names around the saxophone on social media, his videos have reached a million views.

His unique sound, sensibility and virtuosity have made his performances range from opening for Sir Cliff Richard and for Downton Abbey TV Series official concert to performing as a soloist in some of the most prestigious music halls in the world like Philarmonie Berlin, Royal Albert Hall, Royal Opera House, St Martin in the Fields and the 2018 Proms alongside the Britten-Pears Orchestra under the baton of Marin Alsop.

Manu often features on Classic FM, where his first performance was rated as "amazing and 100% colossal". Manu has been a guest on BBC Radio 3 In Tune on multiple occasions since he was named BBCs Introducing Artist of 2018.

Sam Peña

pianist improviser



Spanish pianist Sam Peña is a rare young talent with a unique artistic voice. His style of piano playing is not easy to define, he occupies a space where classical meets pop, folk and film music. It is through his talent as an improviser that he is able to embrace and freely express all of these styles. He is one of the first musicians in the world to have a Conservatoire Level Masters Course specially created for him, a 'Piano Masters in Interpretation and Improvisation' at Guildhall School of Music and Drama, bringing together his skills in jazz, composition and classical. Graduating with Distinction in 2019, he spent the following year as a Fellow with the Composition Department.

During lockdown Sam composed a musical, *One Shoe of Each Colour*, all about his journey as a trans man. Championed by Guildhall as a musical having 'all the ingredients to be the next hit' the piece is garnering much interest from the world of Musical Theatre and is due to be released in 2022. Sam is the resident pianist for DEBUT at Shoreditch Treehouse (No. 1 Airbnb Music Experience Globally in 2018 - Forbes) and he was also part of Yamaha's 'Live From Home' Europe wide Live Stream series.

In addition to our flagship classical music experience DEBUT at Shoreditch Treehouse (Top 5 Airbnb Experience Globally 2018 - Forbes) we have enjoyed sharing our unique and friendly approach to concerts at the Royal Opera House, Cutty Sark, Old Operating Theatre, Russell-Coates Museum and Old Bayham Abbey with Lamberhurst Music Festival. In 2021 we embarked on a new project, DEBUTdrag bringing together the worlds of opera and drag, with an Artists' Residency at The Lighthouse, Poole and were awarded a Genesis Foundation Kickstart Grant for our upcoming Horizon Project.

We've been featured by Steinway & Sons, BBC Radio 3's In Tune, The Opera Awards, Dorset Living, Opera Now and Classical Music Magazine and DEBUT's founder, soprano Lizzie Holmes subsequently returns to the Royal College of Music (where she trained) as a Guest Lecturer on Creative Enterprise.

The Museum is an educational charity and tells the story of one of the world's great engineering dynasties. Brunel organised the world's first underground concert party here in 1827, and the Museum celebrates and interprets music and theatre as well as engineering.

The Tunnel Shaft is a Grade II* listed structure and the world's first caisson. The chamber is half the size of Shakespeare's Globe, and is open again for the first time in a hundred and fifty years. This is where work on the tunnel began, and where Isambard Kingdom Brunel nearly drowned. When it opened in 1843 it was the world's most popular visitor attraction, Brunel organised underground fairs and banquets inside the Thames Tunnel – once described as the Eighth Wonder of the World – in the mid-nineteenth century.



Midnight Apothecary is hosted by Rotherhithe's famous Brunel Museum. Their cocktail garden is built on the rooftop of the Grand Entrance Hall to Brunel's engineering masterpiece, the Thames Tunnel.

The drinks menu is seasonal and constantly evolving. Inspired by and created from plants grown in their garden or foraged close by, their house-made infusions create a menu high on organic and local, low on refined sugar. Midnight Apothecary's careful use of local plant life is designed to compliment the incredible quality of ingredients and flavour in local spirits, beers, tonics and sodas.
